

Acceptable use policy – rules for using ICT in school.

There are some really cool things on the internet, but a lot of bad stuff too.

This means we have to be **SMART** when we are online.

S	SECRET – I will always keep my name, address, mobile number and password PRIVATE – it’s like giving out the keys to your home if you don’t act smart.
M	MEETING someone you have contacted on the internet can be dangerous. I will only do so with a trusted adult’s permission, and then when they can be with me we will all meet in a public place.
A	ACCEPTING emails or opening files from people you don’t really know or trust can be hurtful – they may contain viruses or nasty messages. I will only open files and messages from people who I know and trust.
R	REMEMBER - someone online may be lying and not be who they say they are. I will stick to the public area in chat rooms and if I feel uncomfortable, I’ll simply get out of there! I’ll be smart and log off.
T	I’ll TELL a trusted adult if someone or something makes me feel uncomfortable or worried.
